The 5th ISF meeting, to be held alongside the 2027 Conference, will bring together the community of academics from around the globe in pursuit of research and scholarship in the field of insolvency. The meeting will provide a unique platform for scholars to present cutting-edge research, exchange ideas with leading practitioners and policymakers, and contribute to shaping the evolving discourse on insolvency in India and across the world.

We invite submissions of original and unpublished research papers addressing contemporary issues in insolvency and restructuring. We are particularly interested in submissions in the following areas:

- Reimagining the role of courts, tribunals and judges in the insolvency process
- Insolvency of natural persons, small enterprises, and consumer debt default
- Group insolvency of multinational corporations
- Turnaround as focus of hybrid restructuring mechanisms
- Approach to insolvency in enterprises operating complex sectors of economy

We are happy to consider contributions on related topics.

Presenters of selected papers will have free attendance to the Conference. The accommodation and travel expenses will be borne by the participants. ILA-ISF is pleased to announce that there are limited number of **academic grant** to facilitate the attendance to the Conference. These grants are allocated by ILA, in consultation with ILA-ISF, on a competitive basis.

If you are applying for the grant, please explain why attendance to the meeting is important to you, and what benefits you expect to obtain from attendance.

Selected speakers will be contacted by end of **September 2026** and are expected to submit:

- a 1,500-word outline of their presentation by **30 November 2026**.
- a 5 to 8,000-word article based on their presentation by **30 May 2027**. The ISF Chairpersons will edit the publication of the Conference proceedings, which may be published in peer-reviewed journal(s) and (as an abridged version) on the ILAThinkFactory.
